Our beautiful and historic parish church has been the centre of the Wendover community for over 700 years.

Services

We meet at St Mary's Church in Church Lane, Wendover, for our two main Sunday services each week, which start at 9.00am and 10.45am. The 9am service is more traditional and the 10.45am services include Connect, create and celebrate- our integrational service and Digging Deeper, a time to explore questions about the Bible and life important to us all. We also have a 10am Said Holy Communion Service every Thursday..

Music

Those of us who are involved in making it, believe that music is an integral part of what makes us human – and our humanity is where we are touched by God. In all we do, therefore, as musicians at St Mary's, we aim to illuminate and enrich our response to God and lead the congregation in going deeper into the mystery of faith.

Bells

Our bellringers practice every Tuesday evening, usually from 7.30-9pm. The bells are rung for our regular Sunday services, between 10am and 10.30am as well as for additional services, weddings and funerals.

Flowers

St Mary's is well known for its flowers, which complement our worship and the beauty of our church building. We have a lovely team of flower arrangers who arrange the church flowers on an annual rota but have three Church Festivals during the year (Easter, Christmas and Harvest) when we hope all the team are able to show off their talent!

Walks

Wendover in the Chiltern Hills is surrounded by beautiful countryside and we are fortunate to have a number of special attractions – such as Coombe Hill, Wendover Woods, Weston Turville Reservoir, The Ridgeway and The Grand Union Canal (Wendover Arm) – all within easy walking distance. Our walks are open for anyone to join us so feel free to come along and to bring friends or dogs along with you. Walking is really good exercise and is also a great way keep in touch or make new friends.

Senior Ages

Sages is a monthly morning meeting for Senior Ages. It provides a great opportunity for chatting to those of a similar age over a cup of coffee or tea, and a cake or two. This is followed by a talk or presentation of interest to our age-group and we usually conclude with a brief thought and prayer. SAGES is open to all in the community including members of St Mary's. You will find a warm welcome from the 30+ men and women who regularly attend.

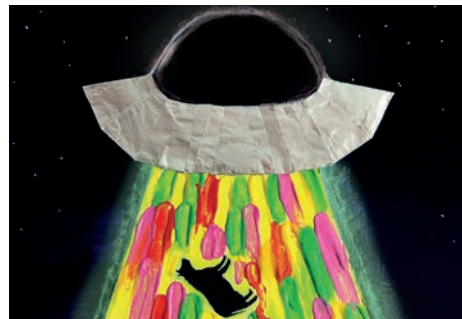
TONY BOWLER
